- Consistent unnaturally high water levels – Why?
- Degraded water quality/stormwater runoff and new development in Eastgate
- **Existing** structures being deemed non-conforming & in most cases not rebuildable
- Your bulkhead, your right to keep it, and maintain it
- Increased restrictions for property redevelopment with large additional costs
- Your home setback being increased 100%
- Your shoreline being required to be 60% vegetated
- Your dock being required to fit unsafe or un-user-friendly standards
- Costly ineffective regulation that fails to improve our lakes
