Planning Commission Meeting to Review SMP

Wed, March 23, 2011, 6:30PM at City Hall

The City has finally released proposed Shoreline Regulations - March 9, 2011 --- after apx 1.5 yrs of theoretical discussions.

The Regulations remove most of the Property Rights of Shoreline Owners.

WSSA (Bellevue citizens - who formed Washington Sensible Shorelines Association) have been attending every Shoreline Master Program - City of Bellevue Planning Commission Meeting(s) - and have been making significant Public Comment from the beginning.

The Regulations are long (355+ pages – a local tax attorney commented they are longer than the IRS tax code!)

Every element of the: Use/ Repair/ Maintenance/ Re-build ability / Re-development/ Enjoyment – of your property is addressed/compromised.

No valid peer-reviewed balanced science corroborates the actions the City is proposing -- which is, THE basic premise/requirement of the Shoreline Management Program (SMP).
