ALERT! Negative impacts to shorelines in Bellevue Planning Commission recommended Shoreline Master Plan Update (SMP) regulations

Save Lake Sammamish (SLS) is concerned about the new draft Shoreline Master Plan currently being considered by the Bellevue City Council. If you live on the lake shoreline in Bellevue consider the following questions.

1. Do you want your view on Lake Sammamish to be blocked by a mega-house, or a simple structure closer to the lake?
2. Does it worry you that new bulkheads and inadequate vegetation may contribute to more erosion of your lot?
3. Do you want to see more shoreline lots closer to the water?
4. Are you concerned about maintaining the water quality of the lake?

Even if you don't live in Bellevue, or on Lake Sammamish, these proposals could have significant impact on your enjoyment of the lake. It is not too late to make your voice heard. Read our position paper (link below) if this is a concern for you.
